Successful Scholars are also engaged in compelling and interesting research that is relevant to African development priorities, contributes new knowledge to their field of study, and holds the potential for transformational change in their communities, and beyond.

The search for our next cohort of PhD Scholars **opens on October 14th, 2019** and **closes on November 22nd, 2019** at midnight East African Time. Applicants will be given a final decision on the status of their application in early 2020 and the fellowship year will commence shortly afterwards. Successful applicants will receive grants for research and conference travel, and participate in a year-long professional development training programme.
